**Order**

**Section 21 of The Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the Prevention of Obstruction  
of Streets set out in this Order**

**WHEREAS on Saturday Fourth day of November 2023** between the hours of **17.00 and 21.00**, the roads specified in the Schedule hereto will be thronged and liable to be obstructed because of the holding of the **Gainford bonfire and firework display**. The County Council of Durham, pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of The Town Police Clauses Act 1847, does **HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that, for the purposes of preventing obstruction, the said roads shall be closed during this time to all vehicular traffic, including pedal cycles and motorcycles, with the exception of access for emergency vehicles.

The penalty for infringement of the said regulation is a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
